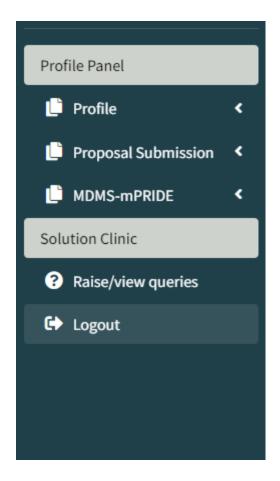
## Manual for Principal Investigator

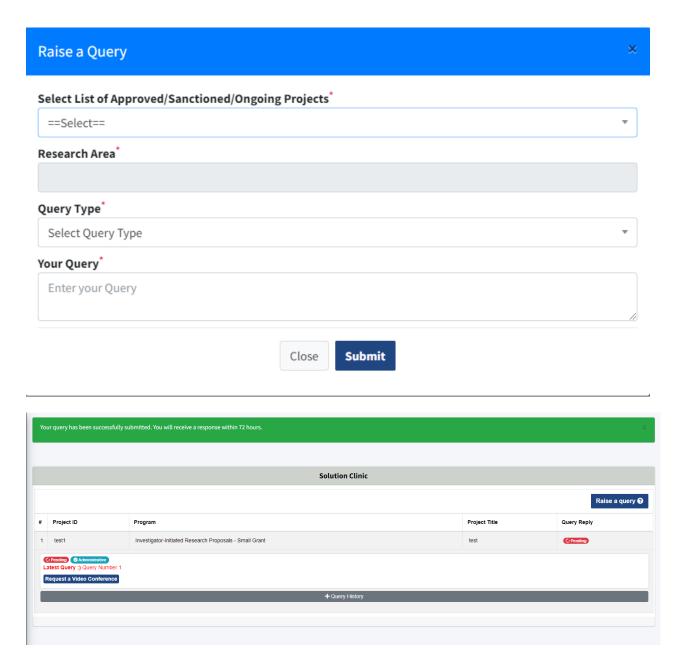
- 1. Login to your ePMS Dashboard <a href="https://epms.icmr.org.in">https://epms.icmr.org.in</a>
- 2. Go to Raise/View Queries under Solution Clinic
- 3. Click on 'Raise a query' in the blue tab on the upper right corner.
- 4. Click on your 'Approved/Sanctioned/Ongoing Projects' from the dropdown against which the query has to be raised.
- 5. Select Query Type Administrative, Scientific or Financial.
- 6. Explain your query in brief under 'Your Query' field.
- 7. Click on Submit . You will receive a confirmation mail regarding the submission of the query.
- 8. The Program Officer for the project will reply to the query.
- 9. If further query has to be raised, click on 'Re-query' under Query Reply.
- 10. You can also access the response to previous queries by clicking on 'Query History'.
- 11. An option to avail Video Conference (VC) will be active after 72 hours of a raised query. To request for a Video Conference, kindly click on the blue tab below the query 'Request a video conference'.
- 12. Select the date and time from the available list of slots from the calendar. A confirmation mail regarding the same with video conference link will be sent.





Step 2 - Click on 'Raise a query' in the blue tab on the upper right corner.



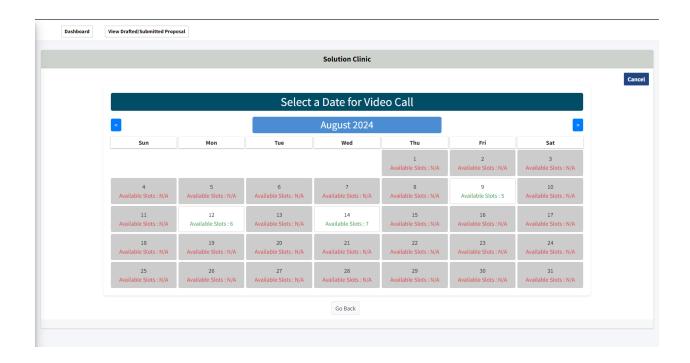
Step 3 – Select your proposal and the query type from the dropdown and raise your query.



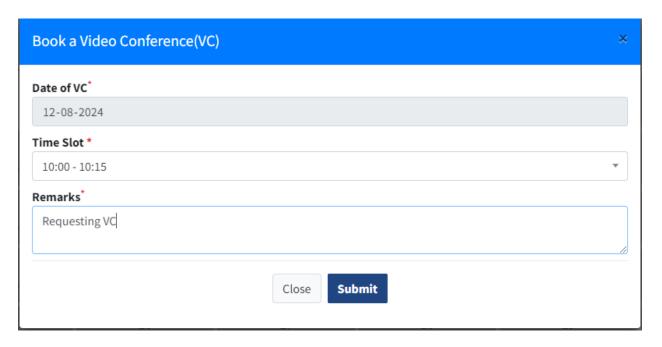
One can access the response to previous queries by clicking on 'Query History'.
